Important notes:

- Most organizations require individuals to submit an application approximately six weeks (Except CDC ~ one week) in advance in order to take the test on a specific date at a specific location. The individual cannot show up on the date of the test and take it.
- Each organization rotates its test sites around the country or state (see the web site for each organization's test schedule and locations). Therefore, travel may be required. The test may be offered in a state only once per year or less.
- For these reasons, it is very important to start collecting information about requirements, fees, application deadlines, test schedules and locations, etc. as early as possible.
